

# Lesson 13

## Add9 Chords

The **add9** simply means that you add the note 9 steps away from the root. For instance, in a C(add9) chord, the note nine steps away from C, the root, is D: C-D-E-F-G-A-B-C-D.

## Exercise No. 1

Exercise No. 1 is a guitar exercise in 4/4 time. It consists of two measures. The first measure starts with a G major chord (002033) and features a sequence of eighth notes: G4, A4, B4, A4, G4. The second measure starts with a C(add9) chord (x32010) and features a sequence of eighth notes: C4, D4, E4, D4, C4. The exercise ends with a double bar line.

\*Optional: Play Em7 instead of Em throughout song. Keep 3rd finger down on 2nd-string D throughout.

## The One I Love

The One I Love is a guitar piece in G major and 4/4 time. It is divided into several sections:
 

- INTRO:** Features an optional melodic line and chords: Em7 (020233), Dsus2 (xx0232), and Em (020233).
- VERSE:** Chords: Em (020233), Dsus2 (xx0232), Em (020233).
- CHORUS:** Chords: Em (020233), Dsus2 (xx0232), Em (020233). Includes performance directions: "1st time: D.S." and "3rd time: 4X, then TAG".
- SOLO:** Chords: G (002033), Dsus4 (xx0432), G (002033), C(add9) (x32010), Em (020233).
- TAG:** Chords: Dsus2 (xx0232), Em (020233), D.S., Em (020233), Dsus2 (xx0232), Em (020233). Includes a triplet of eighth notes over the final Em chord.
